About the Walk:

The technical walk comprises:

- A walk through the Blue House Cluster (mainly on Blue house and Yellow House);
- Introduce the Viva Blue House Revitalization project by giving an account on the heritage significance of the site and sharing the challenges of technical complexity of the conservation works;
- Introduce the adoption of phased construction approach to fulfill the majority wishes of existing residents to stay and maintain their social network alive during the working period;
- Overview the preserved mixed-use tenement houses character by embracing a range of different uses after the revitalization. Beside renovated residential units for existing and new tenants, traditional dessert restaurants, shops and museum for holding cultural and community programs and show flats interpreting the early living days of the Cluster will be preserved for both social and public appreciation;
- Explain the strike of balance between minimum intervention and modification work within the cluster for new uses by providing statutory sanitary provisions and current living facilities to improve the standard of living whilst maintaining the original characters of the building
