<u>Highlights of the Seminar</u>:

Key information, introduction of construction and work procedures of SCL Immersed Tube Tunnel (IMT) will be briefly described. The IMT is constructed from Hung Hom to Admiralty Section. It extends East Rail Line across the Victoria Harbor to Admiralty Station on Hong Kong Island. A 1.6km SCL cross-harbor tunnel is built by using immersed tube tunneling method. The immersed tube tunnel is composed of 150m pre-cast tunnel segments, which is constructed at ex- Shek O Quarry. The structure will be completed in 2017.
