Abstract:

Many modern buildings nowadays the structure of which are quite complex in design. Situations like structures of extremely huge volume, high headroom, long span, with complicated layout, odd shape, partly or fully composed of precast elements, tension members, basement or structures with

earth retaining elements. Tradition methods for demolition can no longer apply in order to tackle all the concerns behind. It includes safety concerns, of course.

In this seminar, the speakers will share their experience and illustrate what the challenges are commonly facing in those kinds of demolition works. This includes the application of different special techniques and technology such as using of diamond-saw cutting, boring, hydraulic splitting, remote-control robots, super-high pressure water jetting, or a combination of these methods, and in some cases with the assistance of visual systems and BIM.
