

# The Council of Hong Kong Professional Associations (COPA) EcoPark and WEEE·PARK Visit

(環保園/廢電器電子產品處理及回收設施)@ Tuen Mun Area on 16 March 2019



EcoPark, Hong Kong's first recycling-business park being in operation since 2007, which is a facility of the Environmental Protection Department specially constructed for recycling industry. Situated in Lung Mun Road, Tuen Mun, with a site area of 200,000 sq.m., EcoPark is developed in two phases and provides a rentable area of 140,000 sq.m. long term land at affordable costs for the recycling industry. EcoPark endeavors to promote the turning of waste into resources by returning recyclable materials to the production line and the consumption loop, promoting the development of the local environmental and recycling industry. Eleven lots of EcoPark have been leased for the recycling of waste cooking oil, waste metals, waste wood, waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE), waste plastics, waste batteries, construction and demolition waste, waste glass, waste rubber tyres and food waste.

Apart from the main facility located in the EcoPark in Tuen Mun, WEEE·PARK is expanding its collection network in the territory, with the ultimate target of setting up five Regional Collection Centres and eight Collection Satellites. With a smart tracking and reporting system, the network provides logistics support to facilitate the fleet in the collection of regulated WEEE disposed of by members of the public from premises across Hong Kong. WEEE·PARK is also providing support to retailers in their provision of statutory free removal service in respect of regulated WEEE. WEEE·PARK is designed to treat 30,000 tonnes of regulated WEEE annually. There is an exhibition corridor at WEEE·PARK, and guided tours are arranged for members of the public to get a better understanding of the recycling and treatment processes of WEEE, as well as a deeper appreciation of the importance of turning waste into resources.
